SAFE ARRIVAL

Dear Kate S Durdan Parents/Guardians:

At District School Board of Niagara, one of our greatest priorities is ensuring that our students arrive safely at school each day.

To enhance our existing absence checking procedure, we have a more efficient student absence reporting system called **SafeArrival**. This system will reduce the time it takes to verify student attendance, make it easy for you to report your child's absence and easy for staff to respond to unexplained student absences.

With **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these three convenient methods:

- Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Use the SafeArrival website, at <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Call the toll free number 1-866-606-5567 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.



found above and on the following page. On schoolcashonline you can find the DSBN Permission to Participate Forms for Physical Education and Technology use. To register for schoolcashonline, you will need your child's first and last name and date of birth. Please note: new JKs/new to the country may not yet be able to access this program. Please check by Friday, September 8th. You will need the School Messenger App to report daily absences and lates OR call the following number: 1 800 606 5567. For school messenger to work, you must register using the same e-mail we have on file at the school.

Kate S. Durdan Public School uses School Cash Online, a safe and secure online portal, that gives you the freedom to approve permissions forms electronically and make payments for school items and events using echeque, credit or debit card.

With School Cash Online, you will be able to approve permission forms and make payment for trips online. Rather than sending cash to school with your child on pizza days, you can pre-order online. The preferred method of payment for item purchases at Kate S. Durdan is School Cash Online.

Separate Accounts for Parent/Grandparents

Students can be added in up to five different "parent" accounts.

User Registration

Step 1 – Enter your first and last name.
Step 2 – Enter your demographics (address, phone, e-mail)
Step 3 – Password – set up your password
** I want to receive email notifications for new fees assigned to my student and updates on school-related activities.
At least one parent should be receiving e-mail notifications to stay informed of new purchases (eg: pizza days).

Add a Student

Student Number – leave the box checked (I don't have the student number). Enter First and Last Name (Legal name). Birthdate – MM/DD/YYYY must be in this format. Make sure there are no spaces before or after the names. CONFIRM. If there is more than one child, continue adding students.

There are 5 tabs on the Home Page. You can check ITEMS and PAYMENT HISTORY at any time to see if you have placed an order. If you are using "MY WALLET, you have to transfer money to My Wallet either by E-Cheque or using a VISA or MasterCard. You then have to place your order and use My Wallet to pay for your purchases.
